The events of 2020 have led to an unprecedented focus on the trajectory of higher education. *Will universities become more socially just? How will technology change teaching and learning? What future are colleges and universities educating workers for?*

EDUC 715 is an opportunity for graduate students to explore and construct higher education's future in consultation with today's postsecondary leaders.

We will build analytically grounded case study scenarios for actual colleges and universities, drawing on data, commentary, and student-led interviews with institutional leaders to explore what higher education might look like for our partner institutions in 20+ years. The course is discussion rich and engages a mix of synchronous and asynchronous learning.
